GROUP WORK

Carbon price (tax) on GHG emissions from agricultural production.

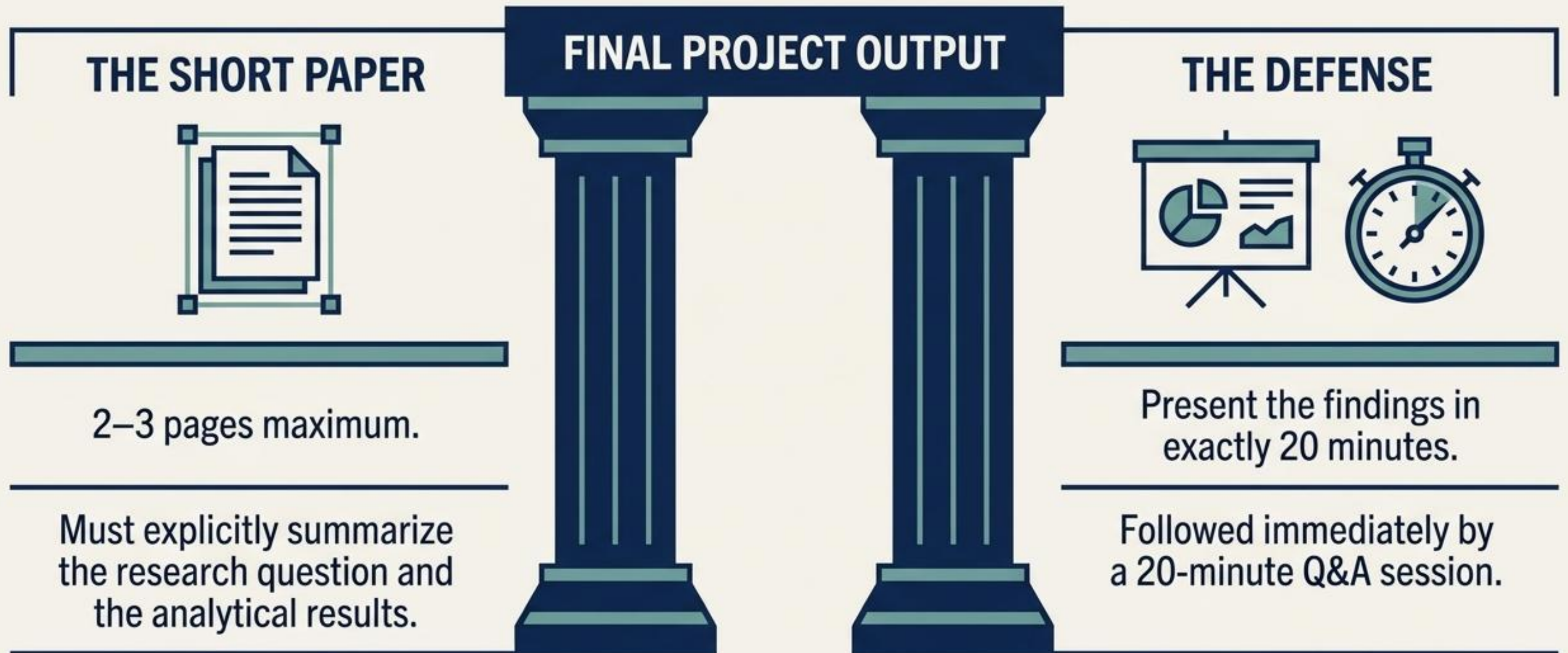
Scenario B

Plant-based dairy alternatives and their impact on agriculture and the environment.

- Which dairy products could be replaced by plant-based alternatives?
 - Drinking milk and yoghurt, cheese on bread and in lasagna, etc.
- Which shares of dairy products may be replaced by 2035?
- Which alternatives could replace dairy products? Which agricultural raw products are they made of?
- What does this mean for the demand for dairy products and for the ingredients for plant-based dairy alternatives?



Weight-loss drugs and their impact on agriculture and the environment

- The new generation of weight-loss drugs (injections like Ozempic, Wegovy) mute appetite substantially and patients eat less.
- The impact on agriculture depends on
 - ... How many people take the drug?
 - How many people are potential patients, i.e. overweight, obese, diabetic?
 - How many are willing to take it? Depends on health insurance cover, costs when patents expire, side effects.
 - ... How much less do people eat?
 - Less of everything? Or less fats/sugar but more vegetables/fruit?
 - ... Is it happening everywhere? High-Income countries only?
